Course Objective

This course aims to increase participants' confidence and competence in caring for patients with life-limiting conditions.

Course Outline

- An overview of palliative care perspectives

- Basic understanding of the end phase of common cancers and non-cancer conditions
- Basic understanding of emergencies in palliative care
- Recognition of final hours and advance care planning
- Revisiting of clinical skills, contextualized for palliative care
- Basic assessment and management of symptoms, signs and psychosocial issues encountered at end-of-life
- Recognition of self care needs
