COURSE OUTLINE



Age-related Eye diseases such as cataract , glaucoma and diabetic retinopathy are the most common causes of visual impairment. These eye conditions have great impact on the independence of the elderly and major cause of falls and injuries.

COURSE OBJECTIVES



This course aims to train nurses and healthcare assistants from the ILTC organisations, in basic understanding of the eye and eye disorders (both refractive and disease), with ability in the recognizing and detecting of eye diseases and enabling them to provide basic ophthalmic care to their clients. The one-day workshop with a mix of lectures and practical, emphasizes on “hands-on” experience visual models and practical illustrations.
